SUNY/PPAA Sponsored College Scholarship

PPAA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

One scholarship in the amount of \$1000 per academic year will be awarded

Eligibility Requirements

- Commitment towards a career in Facilities Management on a college campus.
- Matriculating student with a minimum of 12 undergraduate hours completed.
- 3.0 Minimum GPA
- Preference will be given to SUNY students.

Application Deadline

Completed applications must be submitted no later than May 1st of the award year. Awards will be made in July of that same year at the SUNY/PPAA annual summer conference.

Application consist of:

Letter of application exhibiting their commitment, desire and reason for pursuing a career in Facilities Management.

Applicant shall demonstrate their commitment to a career in Facilities Management by: Documentation of internships, work experience, or acceptable equivalent.

Documented evidence of service to the school or community.

Applicant must submit one letter of recommendation. This letter shall be from current or past professors or professionals. The letter should support the applicant.

All Applications shall include an official transcript from the enrolled college or University.

Selection Method

A selection committee will review all applications.

Phone interviews with short listed candidates by the committee.

Decision of committee is final.
